

GRAIN BAG RECYCLING



WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO TO HAVE YOUR GRAIN BAGS RECYCLED?

As soon as possible after you have finished using the grain bags:

- Make sure they are emptied of grain, and as clean as possible (remove dirt etc.) and with no vermin whatsoever.
- Cut the bags into sections of no more than 10 metres in length.
- Fold the bag sections and secure them together (e.g. with baling twine).
- Bring the secured bags to your nearest collection point.

WHAT HAPPENS TO YOUR GRAIN BAGS?

Once your bags are collected they are transported to a central location where they are then cleaned of excess dirt and visible contamination. The bags can then be shredded and converted into pellet sized particles, where they can then be melted and moulded into a variety of products. The UV resistant qualities of this product make it ideal for outdoor products including fencing, planks, beams, bollards, decking, outdoor furniture, pots, and much much more.
