Introducing free green waste for residents and ratepayers in 2024/25

Users are required to separate rubbish types for depositing at designated areas within each site. Please keep the following items separated:

- Green Waste
- General Household Waste
- Hard Rubbish
- Tyres
- Chemical Drums (triple rinsed only)
- Concrete
- Steel
- E-waste
- Mattresses

WHY SHOULD WE RECYCLE?

Recycling helps to reduce what we send to landfill and provides material for new products made from recyclable material. Meaning it is not only good for the environment but for the economy as well. Most residents now have access to both glass and mixed recycling bins. Please take note of what can go into each so that we have as little contamination as possible.

All users must report to the site attendant, pay the appropriate charge and deposit their rubbish as directed by that attendant.

Attendants will check each load to ensure that only items accepted in each area are being dropped off there.

ASBESTOS DISPOSAL SERVICE

Council's asbestos disposal service allows for up to 25 kilograms per household, per day to be dropped off at council transfer stations at Warracknabeal, Hopetoun and Murtoa. Each parcel needs to be double wrapped in builder's plastic.

The cost of disposal is \$2 per kilogram - weighed at the Transfer Station. If additional wrapping is required, the cost is \$2 per package under 10 kilograms and \$5 per package between 10 and 25 kilograms.

FREE GREEN WASTE INFORMATION

Free Green Waste is now available for residents and ratepayers of the Yarriambiack Shire Council.

This offer will not be available to businesses or commercial entities.

Free green waste will be applied to a load up to the equivalent size of a 6 x 4 trailer or 1 cubic metre of green waste. If the load exceeds 1 cubic metre, the balance over 1 cubic metre will then attract a fee.

Transfer station operators will require customers to demonstrate that they are a resident or ratepayer of the Yarriambiack Shire.

Transfer station operators will continue to monitor the contents of any vehicle being bought in to the transfer station, all other wastes or items to be disposed of will attract a fee.
