ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON REVERSE.

Fees and requirements.

- Permit application fee is \$50-00.
- All Permit fees must be paid when the application is lodged with Council.
- The application fee is non refundable and any permits issue are subject to a property / location inspection prior to the permits approval.
- No activity stated on an application is to commence prior to the permits issue.
- Permits issued shall include various set standards to be maintained by the applicant.
- Any breach of these conditions may result in the permit being cancelled until the breach is rectified.
- If a breach of this permit is not rectified within the specified time Council may order the permanent removal of the offending items, and penalties may apply.

Life of permit.

- For Dogs and Cats the permit shall remain in effect for 2 years from the date of issue.
- For all other animals the permit shall remain in effect for 1 year from the date of issue.
- For all other activities the permit shall remain in effect for one year unless otherwise specified by the issuing Officer.
